Board Expectations

Duty of Loyalty – Activities must be done in the best interests of the organization and not of the individual Board member or their professional interests when acting on behalf of the organization in a decision-making capacity.

Duty of Obedience – Board members bear the responsibility of ensuring that the organization complies with the rules as defined by the governance documents.

Board Member Responsibilities:

- Participate in an inclusive environment that recognizes inherent differences and systemic actions that have led to lasting trauma and inequalities and be a supporter and advocate for change for the youth we serve.
- Actively participate in all meetings, attending board meetings and contributing to the discussion.
- Hire and support the Chief Executive Officer.
- Be an advocate for Street Culture Project Inc. by supporting fundraising efforts by participating and sharing networks.
- Advance Street Culture Project Inc. mission.
- Fulfill legal and fiduciary responsibilities.
- Recruit new members who will contribute positively to Street Culture Project. Inc.
- Advocate in the best interest of Street Culture Inc.
- Participate on committees.
- Lead by example and hold yourself to a standard that represents the organization in a positive light.
